



Dr. oec. Andreas Alioth received his doctoral degree in management sciences from the University of St. Gallen, Switzerland, with a focus on organization development and human resources management. After employment in industry he joined the Institute of Work Psychology at the Federal Institute of Technology in Zurich in 1974 and also served as a consultant to various companies. From 1977 to 1979 he was corresponding member of the International Council for the Quality of Working Life. Between 1982 and 1989 he was the Program Director of the National Research Program 15 "Workplace Humanization and Technological Development". From 1989 to 1991 he was a member of the National Expert Commission "Switzerland Tomorrow". Andreas Alioth was a lecturer at the University of St. Gallen, Switzerland, and an editor of the publication series "Worklife". He was also a lecturer at the Business School of Solothurn, Switzerland.
